ASBCPA Overview of powers

- Early and informal interventions *
- Civil injunction*
- Criminal behaviour order*
- Dispersal power*
- Public spaces protection order*
- Community protection notice
- Closure power
- Absolute grounds for possession



Early and informal interventions

- Not mandated but encouraged to resolve issues:
- Community resolution
- Mediation
- ABC/ABAs
- Parenting contracts
- Support and counselling

Civil injunction

- Nuisance or annoyance
- Held in youth court for u18s
- Can have positive requirements
- Penalty on breach a supervision order
- Last resort detention order

Criminal behaviour order

- YOT views must be sought
- Breach sentenced through youth court
- Positive requirements can be applied

Dispersal powers

- Harassment alarm or distress
- Low level of authorisation
- No consultation necessary

- Breach is a criminal offence
